With 20 new 1st grade students, the school started with 109 students.

In addition, the school building and kitchen are scheduled to be renovated, and we would appreciate your understanding and cooperation in various activities, such as the start of the second semester lunch program and the opening of the swimming pool by the PTA. Looking ahead to next year, we have also revamped our school educational goals. In the plenary session (deliberation) held on the visit day in February, many parents expressed their wishes for "children who value themselves and others (children who can take care of themselves, children who can express their own good qualities, children who can recognize the good qualities of others, children who are considerate, etc.)" and, with a focus on "children who learn by themselves (children who can think for themselves and act on their own initiative, children who can express their thoughts and feelings, etc.)" and "children who are tough (children who are energetic, children who are persistent, etc.)" At the opening ceremony, in order to explain this school educational goal to the children in an easy-to-understand manner, we introduced it as a keyword beginning with "three 'ji (じ)'". *Note: doesn't translate into English the same.
